

Gathering Helpful Data with iClicker

- Attendance
 - Set to Auto-Run at the start of the term
 - Delete holidays/exam days
- Polling
 - Ask a minimum of one polling question per class.
- Exit Poll
 - End each class with an exit poll

How do you decide what worked and what didn't at the end of a term?



Assessing Your iClicker Data

- Archive your completed iClicker courses
- <u>Export All Activities</u>
- Attendance
 - Which course was the most and least attended?
- Polling
 - Which session had the most and fewest correct answers?
- Exit Poll
 - Which sessions were rated most and least clear?


