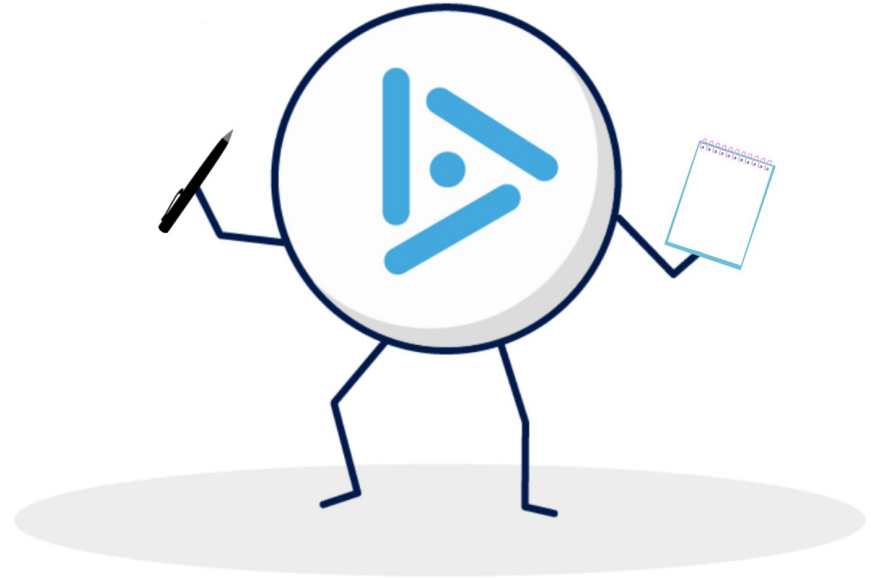

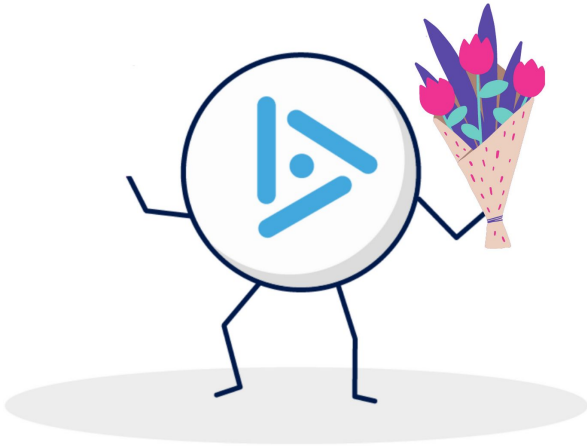
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Introducing iClicker Polling



- Instructors ask students questions and students respond in real time
- Use iClicker with **whatever tools you're already using**
- Students respond with their **mobile devices** (and remotes still work!)
- **No need to preload** questions or answers
- Achieve includes **Instructor Activity Guides**-- fully-developed in-class activities that include iClicker questions

iClicker Features Beyond Polling

- Onboard students easily with the **iClicker Join Code**
- Use **iClicker Attendance** -- set to autorun at the start of the term
- Encourage student reflection with **Confidence Rating**
- End polling sessions with **iClicker Exit Polls** for more feedback
- **iClicker Quizzing** provides an alternative to paper quizzes
- Try **iClicker Assignments** during video lectures, group activities and more
- Allow students to challenge themselves with **iClicker Study Tools**

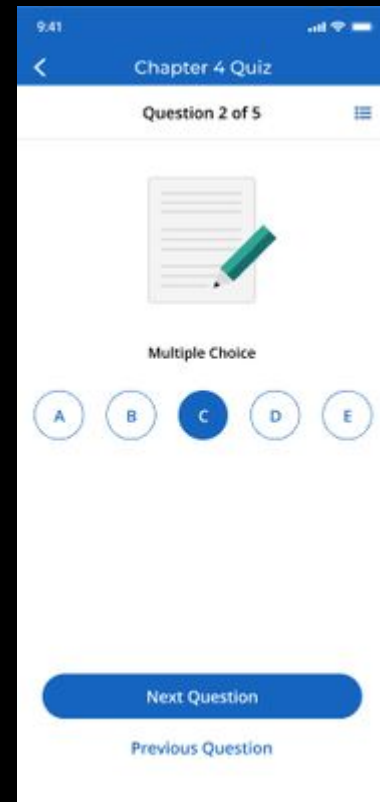
iClicker Quizzing Improvements

- **Available now!**

- **Instructor improvements:** Updated Quizzing settings more closely resemble Polling settings, and the process to start a quiz in class has been simplified.
- **Student improvements:** The experience of taking a quiz more closely resembles responding to a poll or assignment. Navigation between quiz questions and quiz submission have been simplified.

- **Coming soon!**

- **Pre-authored Quizzing:** Easily create, administer, and grade digital quizzes for synchronous classes.
- This new option displays pre-authored questions to students by allowing instructors to upload quiz questions as PDFs.





iClicker Groups - Coming Soon!

Make group work more powerful for you and your students:

- Create student groups that persist throughout the term.
- Move students between groups and add new students easily
- Have students come together in a new way with a **Group Question**
- Students work together to come to consensus

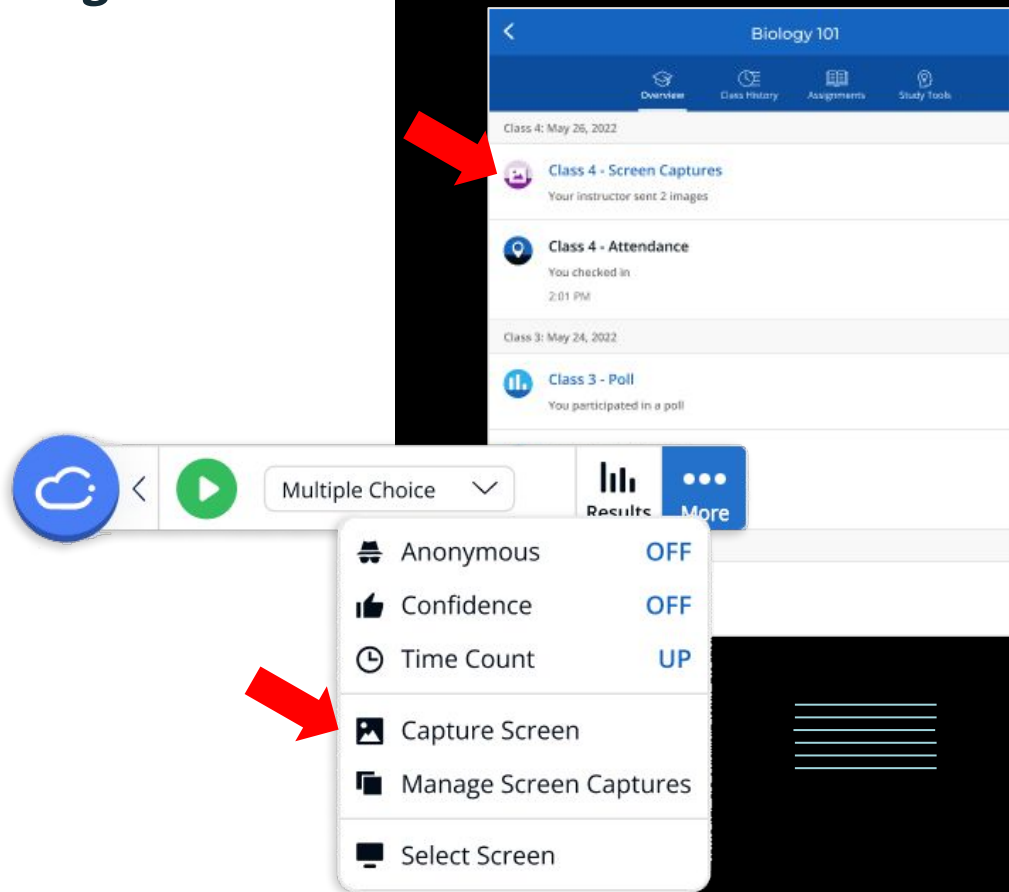

iClicker Screen Capture - Coming Soon!

- A new screen capture option allows instructors to share screenshots with students without having to run a poll.
- Students will have access to the shared lecture slides or other captured content outside of class.
- Students can also create flashcards or a practice test for review using Study Tools in the student app.
