I like the real life samples for the students to see the application of vocabulary and key concepts. Many times they understand the definition, but need examples that show how things are applied for better comprehension.

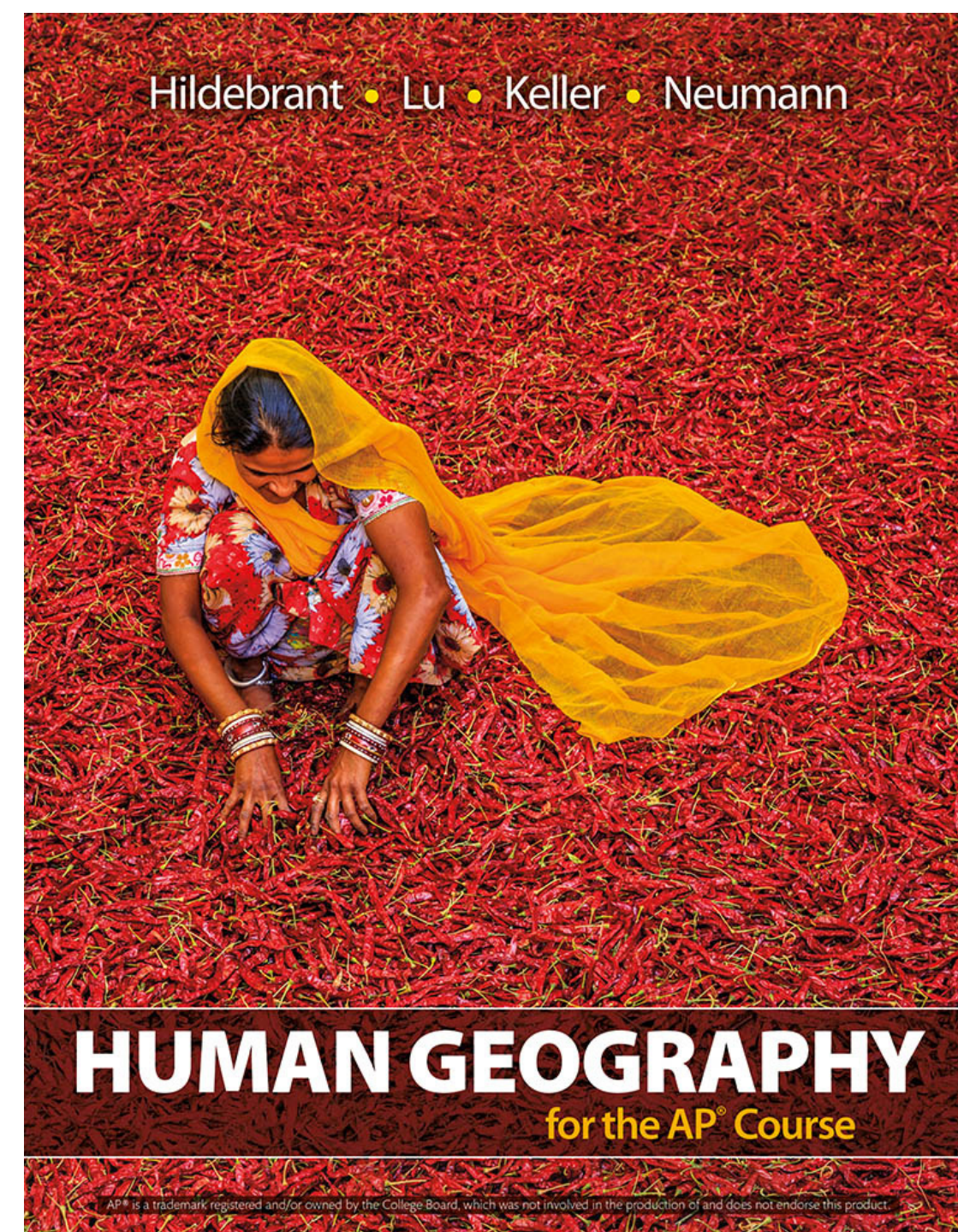
