



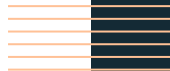
Class Readiness Activity

The questions are meant to provide actionable data for faculty to help set students up for academic success.

Instructions

1. **Using the questions as published?** Skip this step and go to step 2.
 - **Need to edit?** Make any edits to the questions in this PowerPoint (e.g., add questions and delete slides that don't contain questions: slides 1-5) and **save file as a PDF**.
2. **Login** to your iClicker Cloud instructor account at <https://instructor.iclicker.com/>.
3. Navigate to the **Assignments** tab and click **Create** in the upper-right corner.
4. Add the assignment details, including due date, and **upload the PDF file** of the questions.
5. Format the assignment by **selecting question types** (noted on each slide in upper-right corner).
6. Select **Create Assignment**.
7. The assignment will now appear in the iClicker student app.

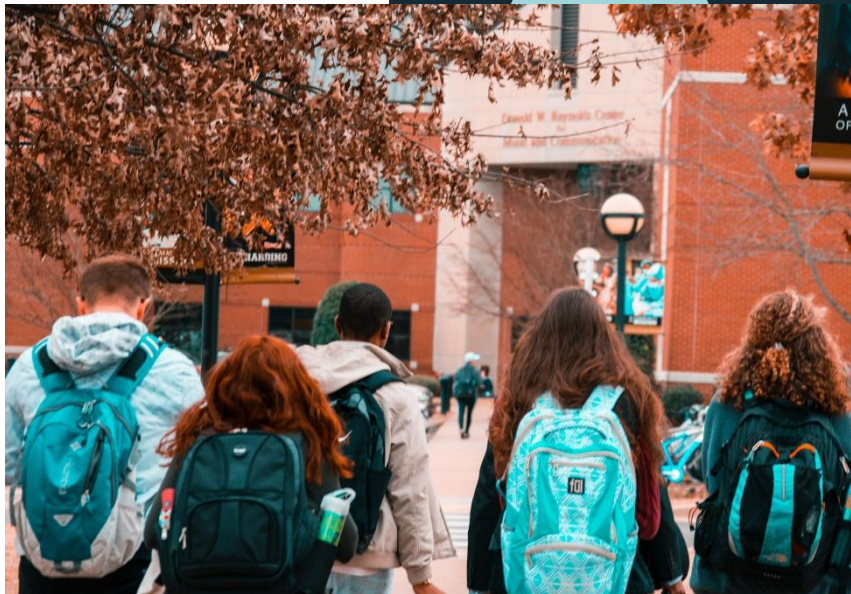
